

CLEAN UP (Job Analysis)

DESCRIPTION:

The Cleanup crew is responsible for emptying trash containers before, during, and after the concert. The majority of the work takes place after the concert, averaging between 30-45 minutes. Cleanup crews are also responsible for picking up reserved tarps, cushions, bagging trash, sorting recyclable glass, etc. Cleanup Volunteers begin work at 6:00pm. 10 to 12 volunteers are needed per show.

FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS

LIFTING (items, frequency, origin, destination, weight):

Frequent. 1-50#. Picking up loose trash to filled trash bags. Picking up and emptying recycle bins.

CARRYING (items, frequency, origin, destination, weight):

Frequent. 1-50#. Carrying loose trash to trash cans. Carrying trash bags from cans to area behind food booth. May need to carrying full trash bags several yards.

PUSHING / PULLING FORCE (items, frequency, origin, distance, force):

1-40#. May need to pull full recycle bins up the hill.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

STANDING: Continuous at end of show and occasional during show

Number of hours: 2-3 hours per shift

How long at one time: 1-2 hours, especially end of show

Type of surface: concrete, dirt and uneven lawn

WALKING: Continuous at end of show and occasional during show

Number of hours: 2-3 hours per shift

How long at one time: 1-2 hours, especially end of show

Type of surface/grade: concrete, dirt and uneven lawn

SITTING: N/A when working, but may sit during the show

CRAWLING: Rare

Number of hours: 20-30 minutes per shift

How long at one time: 1-2 minutes, usually just to reach trash under reserved benches

Type of surface: dirt

KNEELING: Rare

Type of surface: see above, dirt

BENDING: Occasional - Frequent

Doing what: picking up trash on the ground, under reserved seats, trash bags and recycle bins

How often: 5-20 times per hour at end of show and depending on area of the Britt hill

Repetitively?/Sustained?: Repetitively

SQUATTING: Rare

Doing what: picking up trash

How often: 3-4 times per hours depending on location on the Britt hill

Repetitively?/Sustained?:

TWISTING: Occasional - Frequent

Doing what: picking up trash

How often: 5-10 times per hour at end of show

REACHING: Frequent

Above shoulders?: Rare

Below shoulders?: Frequent

Doing what: Picking up trash under reserved benches, pouring heavy glass into recycle bins

How often: 100+ times per hour at end of show

HANDLING (use of hands for gripping, grasping and fine manipulation): Frequent

Doing what: Handling trash

How often: 100+ times per hour at end of show

Repetitively?/Sustained?: Repetitively

ENVIRONMENT (temperatures, humidity):

Humid, hot, possible cool-cold. Rain and/or thunderstorms.

HAZARDS (noise, light, dust, fumes):

Odors from trash, bathroom and alcohol. You may smell like alcohol after you finish this job.

Possible cigarette and marijuana smoke.

EQUIPMENT / TOOLS (hand or power driven):

Brooms, rakes. mops, plungers
