

ICE CREAM BOOTH / POPCORN (Job Analysis)

DESCRIPTION:

Duties include: serving ice cream, cashiering, stocking supplies, making & serving popcorn. All volunteers are expected to help with cleanup of the booth and carts. Job assignment and time of arrival is made by the booth chairperson 1-3 days before the performance. Earliest arrival time is 5:15pm. 10 to 12 volunteers are needed per show.

FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS

LIFTING (items, frequency, origin, destination, weight):

Frequent. 1- 40#. Carrying items, products from storage to display. Set up display or food items to process and sell.

CARRYING (items, frequency, origin, destination, weight):

Frequent. 1- 40#. Carrying items, products from storage to display. Set up food items to process and sell.

PUSHING / PULLING FORCE (items, frequency, origin, distance, force):

Occasional 1-40#. Pushing ice cream or popcorn cart into position.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

STANDING: Frequent

Number of hours: 4-5 hours per shift

How long at one time: 1-2 hours

Type of surface: concrete, lawn but may be uneven

WALKING: Occasional

Number of hours: 2-3 hours per shift

How long at one time: 15-30 minutes

Type of surface/grade: concrete, uneven lawn, dirt and loose gravel

SITTING: Occasional- Frequent, depending on assignment

Number of hours: 10 minutes - 2+ hours

How long at one time: variable depending on assignment

Type of surface: hard surfaced chairs

CRAWLING: Rare

Number of hours: N/A

How long at one time: 1-2 minutes

Type of surface:

KNEELING: Rare

Type of surface: concrete and uneven lawn

BENDING: Occasional- Frequent

Doing what: emptying boxes, scooping ice cream, getting ice cream/popcorn out of carts

How often: 20-40 times per hour

Repetitively?/Sustained?: Repetitively

SQUATTING: Rare

Doing what: emptying boxes, retrieving products stored under counters

How often: 2-3 times per evening

Repetitively?/Sustained?:

TWISTING: Occasional

Doing what: stocking products

How often: 1-10 times per hour

REACHING: Occasional-Frequent

Above shoulders?: Rare to occasional. 1-10 times per hour

Below shoulders?: Frequent. 10-30 times per hour

Doing what: Scooping / serving ice cream.

How often: see above

HANDLING (use of hands for gripping, grasping and fine manipulation): Frequent

Doing what: Selling/ handing food

How often: 2-40 times per hour

Repetitively?/Sustained?: Both

ENVIRONMENT (temperatures, humidity):

Possibly cool or very hot. May be very cold if working ice cream. May be exposed to rain or thunderstorms.

HAZARDS (noise, light, dust, fumes):

Loud music, bright lights, cold/ hot temperatures from freezers, popcorn popper.

EQUIPMENT / TOOLS (hand or power driven):

Ice cream scoopers, cash register.
